Our Purpose

The Leicester Psycho-oncology Service provides a service to people in Leicestershire and Rutland who are living with cancer. We are a very down-to-earth service that looks at some of the emotional difficulties people face following a diagnosis of any form of cancer (includes lymphoma, leukaemia, myeloma and melanoma).

We are very used to helping people who are depressed after a diagnosis of cancer, but we deal with many other problems including:

Persistent distress	Communication problems
Severe anxiety	Adapting to changed lifestyle
Anger	Worries about body image
Suicidal thoughts	Low self-esteem

We also have close links with medical psychology. Occasionally medical and nurse students and researchers work with us.

What Can We Offer?

We offer a range of treatments and always try and find the best one for you. Each treatment will only be given with your agreement and you can stop treatment if it does not suit you. We will not give you any treatment which interferes with your medical treatment.

Treatments that may be recommended include:

Emotional support	Face-to-face talking therapy
Graded activity planning	Cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT)
Antidepressants	Group therapy
Tailored information	Relaxation programmes

Coming to See Us

Any professional involved in your care can refer you to us. This would usually be your cancer specialist, nurse specialist or GP. Attendance is entirely voluntary and you will be treated with respect and given time and space to talk about the things that are worrying you.

If you have special difficulties coming to our clinic at Leicester Royal Infirmary, we could see you at Glenfield Hospital, Leicester General Hospital or LOROS. If necessary we can see you at home or arrange transport for you.
